

## Public Notice: 2014 Kerbside Bin Audit

Between 27 and 31 October 2014 Fleurieu Regional Waste Authority will be undertaking a kerbside bin audit to assess the performance of the current kerbside collection system.

A small number of randomly selected waste, recycling and green organic bins from across the region will be collected separately to the usual collection.

The bins sampled from each stream will remain anonymous. The content of sample bins per waste type will end up together in collective samples and auditors will weigh and assess the content of each waste stream.

The audit results will provide valuable data to FRWA regarding the amount and type of waste currently presented at the kerbside for collection and assist to:

- Determine the performance of the current kerbside collection system of weekly collection of general waste (140L bins);
- Determine the performance the 4-weekly collection of recyclables (240L yellow lidded bin) and greenwaste (240L greenbin);
- Provide feedback to the community on their recycling efforts; and
- Better plan future recycling and waste reduction strategies.
